

**Public Notice**  
**Proposed Substantial Amendment to Reallocate**  
**HOME-American Rescue Plan Program (HOME-ARP) Funds**

Public Notice is hereby given that the City of Chattanooga will consider an amendment to its 2021-2022 Action Plan to reallocate HOME-ARP funds.

Administered through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD's) HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), the American Rescue Plan (ARP) provided funds to eligible communities to reduce homelessness and increase housing stability by assisting individuals or households who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, and other vulnerable populations, by providing housing, rental assistance, supportive services, and non-congregate shelter. The City of Chattanooga received an allocation of \$2,966,210.00 and budgeted it as follows:
