Recommendations Regarding Abandonment Request


I have completed the review of Case No. MR 2021-0074 abandonment of a sewer easement beginning at MH# S101H007 thence some 790 feet southwestwardly and southeastwardly to MH# S101H011. Tax Map Numbers 100E-A-018 and 020 thru 022 as shown on the attached map.

## My comments are as follows:

- The applicant desires to abandon sanitary sewer easement for the proposed construction of townhomes to be built upon the parcels.
- The city of Chattanooga does have sanitary sewer infrastructure in the subject portion of the easement.
