

RESOLUTION NO. 31413

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TRANSFER THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE WILCOX BOULEVARD BRIDGE PROJECT EXPENSES TO THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TDOT), IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$12,822,583.00), PLUS A TEN (10%) PERCENT CONTINGENCY AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT AND 30/100 DOLLARS (\$1,282,258.30), FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF FOURTEEN MILLION ONE HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-ONE AND 30/100 DOLLARS (\$14,104,841.30).

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, it is hereby authorizing the Administrator for the Department of Public Works to transfer the City's share of the Wilcox Boulevard Bridge project expenses to the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT), in the amount of \$12,822,583.00, plus a ten (10%) percent contingency amount of \$1,282,258.30, for a total amount of \$14,104,841.30.

The TDOT will deliver the full project, with the City's share of project expenses provided in the necessary phases:

Engineering Phase (NEPA and Design) - \$843,145.75 (FY 2023)  
Right of Way Phase - \$625,000.00 (FY 2024)  
Construction - \$11,354,437.25 (FY 2025)

There is (1) additional Programmed Federal Funding in the amount of \$2 million (STBG, 80/20 share); and (2) additional funding commitment of \$100,000.00 from Hamilton County. The TDOT is engaging the engineering firm of Alfred Benesch and Company to design the project. The construction contractor for the project will be selected via TDOT's competitive Construction Manager/General Contractor process.
