A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF WASTEWATER TO AWARD THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ON-CALL BLANKET CONTRACT FOR SUPPORT OF WASTEWATER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM FOR ISS – CONTRACT NO.
