

RESOLUTION NO. 32092

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPT THE PORT SECURITY GRANT (PSG) FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) TO BE USED TO PURCHASE TWO (2) FLIR SPECTROSCOPIC PERSONAL RADIATION DETECTORS, ONE (1) RADIO NUCLIDE DEVICE, AND ONE (1) BACKPACK RADIATION DETECTOR USED FOR SPECIAL EVENTS THE CITY HOSTS AS WELL AS FOR ANY EMERGENCY WHERE RADIATION EXPOSURE IS SUSPECTED, IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$47,227.00), WITH A TWENTY-FIVE (25%) PERCENT MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$15,743.00), FOR A TOTAL IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$62,970.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Fire Department to apply for, and if awarded, accept the Port Security Grant (PSG) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to be used to purchase two (2) FLIR spectroscopic personal radiation detectors, one (1) radio nuclide device, and one (1) backpack radiation detector used for special events the City hosts as well as for any emergency where radiation exposure is suspected, in the amount of \$47,227.00, with a 25% match in the amount of \$15,743.00, for a total in the amount of \$62,970.00.
