A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF BROOKLYN BONSKI AS A SPECIAL COMMISSIONED

POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR MCKAMEY ANIMAL

SERVICES, TO PERFORM DUTIES EXPRESSLY LIMITED TO THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES IN HER POSITION AS

ANIMAL PROTECTION OFFICER.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That BROOKLYN BONSKI, be and is hereby appointed as special police officers

for McKamey Animal Services, subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess, and exercise every power

granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police

officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of her duties, except she shall

not be allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police

officer is expressly limited to the performance of duties in her position as Animal Protection

Officer.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and

shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's

employment by McKamey Animal Services. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City

Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointment at any time.
