CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, that it is hereby authorizing the retirement of K-9 Rex as a

service dog.

1) Rex is eleven (11) years old with more than seven (7) years of faithful police

service. During his service, he assisted in the recovery of eighty (80) firearms, over forty (40)

pounds of marijuana, sixteen (16) pounds of cocaine, and seventeen (17) pounds of meth. During

his service, he was responsible for over two hundred sixty (260) apprehensions;

2) At the age of eleven (11), K-9 Rex is facing health issues, including increasingly

severe arthritis, as well as other normal aging effects that make his day-to-day responsibilities

difficult. K-9 Rex will be greatly missed, as he has been a valuable asset to our department since

2017. Therefore, it is recommended K-9 Rex to be retired and placed in the care of his former

handler, Officer Jeremy Wilson;

3) Rex's former handler, Officer Wilson, understands the responsibility of Rex's

retirement; and

4) Officer Wilson has asked to keep K-9 Rex and is willing to accept all

responsibilities for Rex's future care such as medical, food, and housing.
