

RESOLUTION NO. 32588

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF CHATTANOOGA HOUSING AUTHORITY PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER, SPECIFICALLY INVESTIGATOR JOSEPH GOULET AS SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (ARMED) FOR THE CHATTANOOGA HOUSING AUTHORITY, TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That INVESTIGATOR JOSEPH GOULET, be and is hereby appointed as a special police officer (armed) for the Chattanooga Housing Authority, subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess and exercise every power granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to the regular police officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police officer are expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Public Safety Officer.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers by the City of Chattanooga by this appointment.

3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's employment by the Chattanooga Housing Authority. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointment at any time.
