

RESOLUTION NO. 32936

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT ALONG WITH THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPT THE FY26 EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ) TO AWARD A FOUR-YEAR GRANT BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2026, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2030, TO THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE DOLLARS (\$118,999.00) TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING, AND TO AWARD THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY-ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$51,000.00), FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT AWARDED NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE DOLLARS (\$169,999.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Chattanooga Police Department along with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office to apply for, and if awarded, accept the FY26 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) from the Department of Justice (DOJ) to award a four-year grant beginning October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2030, to the Chattanooga Police Department in the amount of \$118,999.00 to purchase equipment and training, and to award the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$51,000.00, for a total amount awarded not to exceed \$169,999.00.
