Major Modification Request(s):

Allowance of a pole sign
 Section 38-753 Sign Types(4)(A)4 Location
 Pole mounted signs are not permitted.

Zoning: E-SH-3 (Commercial Mixed Use Zone)

Applicant Presentation: Applicant Jen Politano presented to the Committee that recently the design topper of the pole sign was taken without permission, but the pole and the base are remaining. They would like to replace it because it is unique to the building and they think it goes along with the building. In the future, a new tenant may want to change the signage on the sign.

Community Response: No Response.

Discussion: The Committee began their discussion by asking the Applicant some questions in regards to the dimensions of the sign and if they plan to build it back to the same dimensions and the Applicant stated that was the plan.
