ORDINANCE NO. 14240

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING, AUTHORIZING OR
ALLOCATING FUNDS TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS BUDGET
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,
TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated, authorized, or allocated the hereinafter set
funds from the sources specified for the public purposes indicated of the Capital Improvements Plan for
the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2026:

SECTION 2. That there be and is hereby authorized the appropriation of all capital donations,
including partnership agreements not previously appropriated, to the projects and the capital fund for
which they are intended.

SECTION 3. That there be and is hereby authorized the appropriation of all interest earned within
the fiscal year to the projects and the capital fund herein identified.
