Part-time Interpreters facilitate cross-cultural communication between staff, families, and the community. This position also works with teachers to build and assess home language development for dual language learners, playing a critical role in improving our cultural responsiveness.

This position works 195 days per year, 6.0 hours per day. Schedules may vary due to work assignments and projects.
